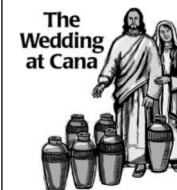

Please ask a Welcomer or a Churchwarden for an application pack if you have not yet signed up. Please remember to collect a laminated card before the Service to place in the collection.

**Gifts From Visitors:** If you are a UK taxpayer, please ask for a white gift aid envelope to increase the value of your gift by 25%.

**Sound System:** There is a loop system in operation, please set your hearing aid to 'T' and adjust the volume as necessary.

**Toilet and Baby Changing Facilities** are available in the temporary office / toilet building at the rear of Church House car park.

**Parking** is available in the small car park adjacent to Whithern Park. The Council informs us that the gates will not be locked.
